Report on Bio-composting

Objectives: Managing waste matter to convert into compost and using it to pamper the greenery.

Compost is organic matter that has been decomposed in a process called composting. This process recycles various organic materials otherwise regarded as waste products and produces a soil conditioner. Compost is rich in nutrients and it is used for garden and green. The compost itself is beneficial for the land in many ways, including as a soil conditioner, a fertilizer, addition of vital humus or acids, and as a natural pesticide for soil. In ecosystems, compost is useful for erosion control, land and stream reclamation, wetland construction, and as landfill cover

At IMR Institute leaves of various trees and other compostable waste is collected in one large tank and it is left for decomposition. After it is converted into compost we use it for garden.




